The institute materials' fee is a non-refundable charge of \$125. ### FLORIDA STATUTE 1003.42

Be It Enacted By The Legislature Of The State of Florida, May 2, 1994

#### Required Public School Instruction

The history of the Holocaust (1933-1945), the systematic, planned annihilation of European Jews and other groups by Nazi Germany, a watershed event in the history of humanity, to be taught in a manner that leads to an investigation of human behavior, an understanding of the ramification of prejudice, racism, and stereotyping, and an examination of what it means to be a responsible and respectful person, for the purposes of encouraging tolerance of diversity in a pluralistic society and for nurturing and protecting democratic values and institutions.



For a decade, Rositta E. Kenigsberg, President of the Holocaust Documentation and Education Center and Founding Chair of the Commissioner's Task Force on Holocaust Education, spearheaded the effort which finally resulted in the passage of the state of Florida Statute 1003.42 (above) which was signed into law in April 1994. This funded legislation, which was written by Rositta E. Kenigsberg, mandates Holocaust education for all Florida students from K-20 and provides teacher training and resources.
