I would like to congratulate the Holocaust Documentation and Education Center on providing another year of invaluable assistance, support, and education to Florida Survivors and our community.

Working together with the International Commission on Holocaust Era Insurance Claims, Survivors in the State of Florida have received over \$13 million in claims payments from European insurance companies. Humanitarian payments of \$1,000 have been received by 1,400 Florida residents, for a total of \$1,400,000. Thank you to the Holocaust Documentation Center for all of your support in those efforts.

Although ICHEIC has closed its doors, the ICHEIC member insurance companies, as well as companies in the German Insurance Association, have reiterated their commitment to continue to review and process claims sent directly to them in accordance with ICHEIC's rules and guidelines.
